Since the first time I heard about mission trips being a thing that people do, I've thought "That's an amazing thing to do! But I'm probably never going to do it." Every common excuse you could think of has run through my mind by this point:

"That's really expensive! I could never afford to do something like that." "I don't really have anything to offer people in need," "I wouldn't last long so far out of my comfort zone." "Sure I could try to raise money or something but I'm really bad at that." "Plenty of other people already do it, so why should I?"

There's an important truth that I'm learning to live by that's slowly but surely giving me the courage and boldness I need to look past those excuses and finally embark on a long journey to a foreign land, come face to face with extreme poverty, like I've never seen before, and allow God to give me something valuable that He will in turn use me to give to the people I'll meet there." <u>READ MORE</u>
