

### No More Safety Pins: August 16 - 18, 2018

Grace Klein Community wants to care for the frazzled mama who doesn't have time or resources for another season. Clothing children for fall/winter does not have to be a stressor or a budget breaker.

Shopping scenario: "Frazzled mama has no time for hangers, tags and safety pins. She participates in "No More Safety Pins" by bringing 50 excellent quality items and paying \$25 on a "drop off date." She trades in the 50 items to receive 50 new items on the shopping weekend. If she wants 20 more items, she pays in another \$25. Frazzled mama's friend comes with her without trading any items, so she pays \$25 for every 20 items she selects."

The comparisons below will be the full 2017 statistics versus January-July 2018:

"I greet you in the name of our loving Lord Jesus Christ. By God's grace, with your prayers and support, we have been doing well and God has been providing opportunities to preach and share the gospel and also start various ministry outreaches in the slum, Santhom colony.

Santhom Colony: We are thankful to The Lord for opening doors into Santhom Colony. The Lord has been so gracious. He has been guiding us and He has been protecting us, giving us wisdom and discernment to continue in this slum. The colony is suffering from many issues such as no homes, no toilets, some men are involved in crime, drug peddling, some women are involved in prostitution, some women send their teenage girls into prostitution, families struggle from financial debts, and many have no proper income on monthly basis, etc.

# **Overflowing Into Our Laps**

Our expansion project has been a test of faith, courage, trust, obedience and stick-to-itiveness. From our <u>50k50days</u> campaign to the journey of walking out the renovation as God sends the funds and the help, He has grown us. Oh y'all, He is continually growing us.

Generous donors gave which allowed us to purchase materials to build the extension, to wire it, to install electrical. Spec Building gave us the roofing materials at cost and new volunteers, a couple who recently moved to Birmingham, paid for those materials. Veteran's Roofing discounted their labor to install the roof.

The new room has an amazing HVAC system to keep the new space cool and that system was generously donated by Robbins Complete Services. If you ever need HVAC work, whether a tune up or a new unit, please send business to them. Their phone number is (205) 655-5030.

Norfolk Southern Railroad donated railroad ties that allowed us to build a retaining wall, making space for a safe rear circular driveway. Vulcan Materials is donating aggregate for the driveway. We still need to make more pickup runs from Vulcan Materials when time allows for the runs. A skilled bobcat operator came and worked on the driveway with the donated gravel that we have received from Vulcan. We are having some drainage issues that is impacting the stability and compaction of the aggregate and we will need to add some gutters to help organize the runoff. The corrected berm in the right side alley is also helping with water diversion as we receive all the runoff from the property above us.



Church of the Highlands selected us as an anchor project for their July 2018 serve day. Over 100 people came to our office and did amazing work, inside and out. They surprised us with flooring for the extension that was installed during the serve. Another skilled carpenter built a beautiful barn door that is stained and installed between the main room and the Give and Take Room. Other volunteers did some painting touch up and by the end of the day our Give and Take Room shelves were relocated and set up in the new room.

They arrive at noon, after food boxes are prepared, make sure our recycling is in order, our shelves are cleaned, and all boxes are loaded in the truck to head to Asbury United Methodist Church for delivery the following morning. They even join in to help unload the boxes.

# **School Supply Drive**

Grace Klein Community referred 90 single moms to one of our partner ministries, Church of the Highlands Grandview, in their efforts to love on moms and kids through school supplies. After the event, we received the overage and another 65 children have been served to date. We plan to share from our overflow at a community outreach hosted by Metro CME Church and other ministries in the Ensley area on August 4<sup>th</sup>.
