

His daily exercise routine is building strength, stamina and helping him return to his goal weight. His left side remains mostly paralyzed, including no use of his left arm.

What Are You Doing For Others?

In 2018, Grace Klein Community hosted 36 serve teams that provided invaluable support and volunteer work force to our day-to-day operations. Without 100 volunteers EVERY week, GKC cannot operate effectively. As we enter 2019, we are trusting for 52 serve teams, to average one a week, to keep us energized and operating smoothly. For January 2019, we are off to an excellent start with 5 incredible groups of people, 7 serve sites, and over 160 people represented. Consider something incredible - these numbers do not include the 59 volunteers who retrieve rescued food every day of the week, the teams who host Sunday Trade Market, or the individuals who SHOW UP throughout the week to lend a hand.
