"We are happy to share the great news that his most recent MRI results are stable and decreased once again and no evidence of tumor tissue! He has been so blessed with prayers and encouragement and he shares that with everyone he meets. He does not miss an opportunity to tell his story. He has voluntarily been part of a quality of life panel and has spent two evenings "giving back" by being a demonstration patient for Emory students in the rehabilitation therapy program. It is his second year to be a part of the program and he enjoys the time with the students, other patients and the therapists.

Sadly his physical therapy sessions have come to an end because all the insurance benefit has been used. We can only say wonderful things about the Emory rehabilitation facilities and the therapist that work so hard to help their patients. They have done everything possible to prepare us to continue Evan's exercises at home. We will miss them since we do not have coverage for 2018. Once again Aetna is discontinuing coverage and there is no policy available to Evan. Please, please pray that insurance will be available from someone for next year. We have contacted doctors, insurance brokers and state market insurance but have been unable to secure coverage. Blessedly, Evan's chemo therapy is completed but he still must take seizure prevention medicines and he remains in the surveillance stage that requires periodic MRI and oncology visits. We know God can provide and appreciate prayers "sent up" on Evan's behalf."
