#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR FOUNDER:

When God gave us the theme "Be A Game Changer" for 2023, I never saw where He was taking us. His plan is always more extravagant than I can see. In 2022 we took a break from the building search, call it fatigue, lack of time, or maybe a better management of time, but we determined to improve our logistics and wait on God. We have been waiting on God and praying for a building for over 5 years, so waiting was not a popular idea. But, we stayed behind Jesus, determined for Him to get the glory in our story.

On our last workday of the year, December 23, 2022, we were invited to tour Morgan United Methodist Church. As soon as I stepped on the campus, I felt immediate peace and believed God was going to unite us. After Pastor Matt gave us a tour and we prayed together, he asked what we needed and I asked him what we could ask for. On January 15, 2023, the church unanimously approved our proposal.

Phase 1 is almost complete before we have the graphics ready to promote the BIG story and we will be beginning Phase 2 in May 2023. We anticipate needing \$325,000 for the entire project which will allow us to move the FeedBHM Headquarters, our food rescue initiative, to their current education building. We will be intaking and distributing food to partners, from the Morgan UMC location, and continuing to operate our current drive thru locations around the community. We will also be using the basement space for further community outreach programs and coming alongside the existing Morgan UMC garden project to "Grow More, Give More," alongside our friends from Jefferson County Master Gardeners.

We cannot wait for you to see what God is doing with our collective YES! Someone from our team will be onsite, Monday thru Friday, from 9-4pm, beginning April 3, 2023. Consider investing financially in the project, bringing your entire team for a work day or coming with your family for a tour. Join us and Be A Game Changer!

### HOW DO WE FIND WORDS FOR WHAT GOD IS DOING AT MORGAN UMC?!

Welcome to the story God is unfolding. Morgan United Methodist Church gifted us shared space and we hosted a Meet and Greet on January 29, 2023, to begin our official partnership together. Since we began, Valleydale Church committed \$10,000 to the project, ACIPCO surprised us with \$12,000 and The Welch Group brought a check for \$35,000, as well as many more in-kind supporters. Plus, early adopters Asbury UMC, Honda, Vulcan Materials, Waverly Advisors, King Simmons and other individuals contributed before we knew of the possibility of Morgan UMC space. Ahead of launching an official fundraiser, the community is seeing the need and taking action.

We are working on our final punch list, purchasing shelving, and sourcing décor such as rugs, furniture and accessories for Phase 1. How will the Phase 1 space be used? Think baby mama support, school supplies, Christmas, shoe collections for Zambia, the We Sew Love repurposing initiative, our Give and Take Room (to share clothing), and community space for troops, Bible studies, and training courses.

Did you know, at Morgan UMC, volunteers have given 1,504 hours (a value of \$45,000 in wage dollars!!)?
