With a 40% combined gap, the only rational explanation is the people we are serving receive less food per person while God multiples the food in real time. Without both options happening simultaneously, the results are impossible.

Write the check, book a serve team, pray for food donations. Your contribution matters. Your belief in the impossible matters. Your Yes Matters!"


