

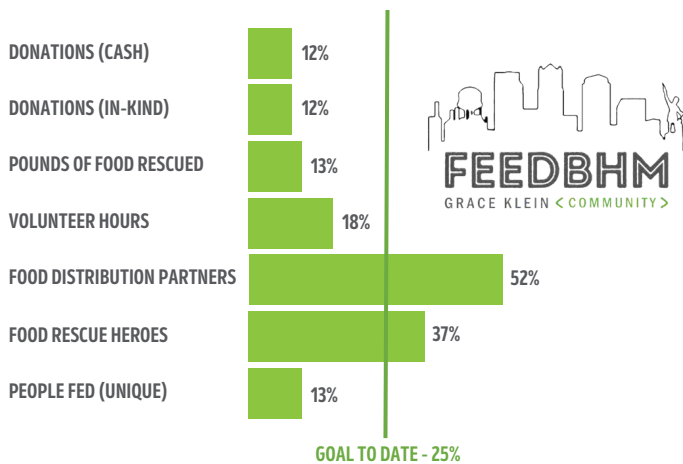

STACKING THE STONES

We have hosted three Networking at Noon events investing in the hearts of 152 business leaders and received special recognition from Greater Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church and Shades Mountain Baptist Church at their respective Global Impact Catalyst Conferences. Dawson Memorial Baptist Church featured us in their Better Together magazine, and Shades Mountain Baptist Church highlighted us as the “Partner of the Month” for February 2024.

Our collaborative projects with Rocky Heights Printing and Binding and their BindeyBooks initiative received media recognition by Bham Now and the Alabama News Center featured our partnership with Sozo Children's Choir. Dr. Bre Mertz of Samford University engaged her social media class as GKC interns, for real-life work experience, increasing our intern count in the first quarter to 45.

We also distributed 130 Easter Baskets to low-income children through our Liberty Church Food Drive Thru, spearheaded by volunteer Rhonda Gibbs. Our March for Hunger initiative mobilized 13 businesses to host collection barrels securing 12,194lbs in food donations. We hosted 123 out-of-state guests, including representation from 10 states and 8 countries, as well as mobilized 65 serve teams, 33% of our annual goal. We incorporated 8 worship nights, an impromptu baptism, and two scavenger hunts, all while managing our day-to-day operations.

Let's continue to gather stones together! We never want to forget what God is doing in our days.
