A MESSAGE FROM OUR FOUNDER:

We are living a story only Jesus could write. A stack of a million little miracles reminds us to never become complacent to the magnificence of who He is! Our expansion into Pelham is a big chapter in the story as He is motivating individuals and companies to contribute and serve Jesus alongside one another in unity. Unity comes from reconciliation which comes from the courage to be vulnerable, transparent and the willingness to forgive each other.

At Grace Klein Community, we partner with hundreds of organizations because we unite around commonalities: loving authentically, sharing what we have so we all have what we need, welcoming the contributions of all, and wise community stewardship. Our common ground reflects the ways of Jesus, basic foundational truths He modeled as He walked the earth, which creates a basis for us to know the power of God together.

We pray about everything, to the point I was praying the other day, explaining to God, “we have so much to pray for, I do not have enough time to pray for it all, and please move in every situation in my heart and mind.” In September, we give intent to purchase 419 Philippians Blvd in Pelham, AL. By faith, I believe God wants us to operate debt free, purchasing the building with \$1.3 million cash. We need to raise \$1 million in the next six months, make a decision to deplete our reserves, or borrow the money. In 2025, 253 individuals and organizations have donated monetarily to the expansion giving towards the total \$2.4 million required for the purchase plus renovations. **We have raised \$425,004.68, and spent \$143,608.94 thus far, but there is more...**

... In the last six months over 1,000 volunteers said yes to the FeedBHM Pelham project, giving 8,303 volunteer hours and providing a wage savings of \$273,251.73 at the new property. Through all tangible donations and skilled labor, we have saved a total of \$701,418.47. Our goal to raise \$2.4M for the entire project is reduced to \$1,273,576.85, after cash and in-kind contributions. We will focus on raising the difference for the purchase and completion of the renovation costs. In-kind giving options are also welcome. We are believing to be fully operational from the FeedBHM Pelham location by early 2026.

11 out-of-state and 312 local serve teams, plus food rescue heroes, families, and individuals contributed 92,653 volunteer hours, a savings of **\$3,049,177.98** wage dollars for the organization, a 62.4% increase from the prior year.

KOINONIA COFFEEHOUSE

The coffee isn't brewing yet, but the Spirit is moving! Even before the official opening, the Koinonia Coffeehouse at FeedBHM Pelham has become a powerful gathering space where people are experiencing authentic community and encountering Jesus.

Already, we've hosted an Easter egg hunt, prayer for Ukraine, the "How to Life Movement" where 175+ students worshipped and shared testimonies, the Iron Sharpening Iron Men's Breakfast, 58:10 Restaurant Group, and more. In total, 726 people have been served in our unfinished space, where God is writing beautiful stories of redemption and unity. 9 students have given their lives to Christ, with dozens more committing to grow in faith.
